



## Elaine Knight Naper

February 13, 1926 - September 22, 2020

Elaine Knight Naper of Chestertown, MD died on September 22, 2020 at Compass Regional Hospice in Chestertown. She was 94.

She was born in Philadelphia, PA on February 13, 1926, the daughter of Milton and Eleanor Kemp Mowbray. She was educated both in the United States and abroad, using her life-long curiosity about a host of topics to guide her.

She married B. Hoff Knight Jr. (January 26, 1922 – December 31, 1968) and later Robert E. Naper (February 1, 1925 – February 25, 2013)

Mrs. Naper worked as an Advertising Copywriter for John Wanamaker in Philadelphia and New York. After moving to Turkey with her family, she was engaged in cultural and social activities as a Foreign Service spouse for ten years. After remarrying, Mrs. Naper volunteered extensively in the Washington metropolitan area.

After moving to Chestertown, Mrs. Naper was active in the League of Women Voters (serving as president from 1989-1991), the All Seasons Garden Club, The Port of Chester Questers and WC-ALL.
