Elaine Rose Steele Mulholland, (affectionately known as “Rosie”), was born in Collingswood, NJ, and raised in Milford, DE.

She was married to Harry Harper Mulholland, Jr., in Rehoboth Beach, DE, at just 18 and became mother to four daughters by her mid-twenties. In 1962, Elaine and Harry settled in Easton at Little Aberdovey, the family home where she enjoyed her last days, watching the sunset over the Tred Avon River. Elaine was 87.

Sixty-three years of marriage to Harry were filled with love, laughter and a lot of singing. An avid bridge player and golfer, Elaine was a long time member of the Talbot Country Club and played on the Ladies Golf team for many years. She was a member of Christ Church, the Tred Avon Yacht Club, the Harbor Club, and President of the Women’s Auxiliary of Easton Memorial Hospital where she was responsible for installing its first Chapel. In the 70s and 80s, she drove for the American Red Cross, making many trips to Tilghman Island, her favorite “run.” Elaine’s enthusiasm for life and adventure was contagious.
