Eleanor M. Reynolds of Easton, MD, died on Friday, March 14, 2008, at William Hill Manor, Easton. She was 91.

Born October 6, 1916, on the Mooreleigh Farm in Talbot County, she was the daughter of the late Harry C. and Cora Willis Moore. After graduating from Tri-County High School in 1934, she attended Beacom College where she earned a secretarial degree in 1937. From 1939 to 1984, she worked as a secretary at Wye Plantation and then volunteered at Memorial Hospital at Easton until 2006.

Her husband of 64 years, T.L. Reynolds, whom she married on New Years Day, 1942, died June 30, 2006.

She was a member of the Queen Anne-Hillsboro Vol. Fire Co. Ladies Auxiliary for over 40 years. She enjoyed reading, visiting with family and friends, and volunteering.

Mrs. Reynolds is survived by her daughter, Diane R. Baynard and her husband Sherman of Centreville; a sister, Florence Messix of Queen Anne; two grandchildren, Tracy Baynard and her husband, Bo Fernhall, and Kristie Baynard and her fiancée, Greg Vanslyke; and one great-grandson, Risdon.
