



## Eliane Murray

April 24, 1926 - March 23, 2017

Eliane Cadilhac Murray, 90, died on March 23, 2017, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton, MD.

Eliane was born on April 24, 1926 in Paris, France. She was the daughter of the late Emile Eugene Cadilhac and Madeleine Jullienne Cadilhac. As an adolescent, she survived the horrors of World War II. She remembered fleeing Paris as the German occupation began. She and her family fled to the hills of Southern France to avoid German capture. United States soldiers found them and helped them survive. Eliane married her husband, Michael H. Murray, on November 16, 1955, in Paris, France.

Eliane's life has been devoted to things of beauty-- art, fashion, and antiques. She studied art at L'École des Arts Décoratifs in France. She worked for Christian Dior in Paris and New York. She also was a freelance interior decorator and appraiser.

She was fully dedicated and committed to her husband and his work as an Episcopal Priest. She was interested in other people, generous, and embraced her French heritage. She was a member of the Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford, MD.

Eliane is survived by her devoted husband of 61 years, The Rev. Michael H.

Murray of Easton; her nephew, Bernard Cadilhac (Cecile) and their family of Douarnenez, France; her stepchildren, Colin D. Murray (Elizabeth) of Jacksonville, FL, and their daughter, Margaret Vencius, and Eric D. Murray (Lynne) of Wyomissing, PA, their two children, Jennifer Funaro, their three children and Brad Murray.
