December 27, 1936 - November 1, 2015

Elizabeth Ann Shortall died on November 1 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville, MD. She was 78.

Born in Centreville, MD, on December 27, 1936, she was the daughter of the late Bryan W. Moore and Clara B. Harrison Moore. She attended Centreville High School, graduating in the Class of 1954. On October 22, 1955, she married her high school sweetheart, Daniel Shortall, and resided in Centreville. She was a homemaker and helped her husband on their family farm.

Mrs. Shortall was an organist for Our Mother of Sorrows and St. Peter's Catholic Churches, where she served on the parish council, as the Parish Liturgy Chairman and CCD Teacher, Women's Chairman of the Farm Bureau, an All-Star for the Queen Anne's County 4-H Park, was a 4H member and leader, serving as a 4H Horticulture Judge and Indoor Chairman, chairman for the Museum of Eastern Shore Life, a member of the Ruthsburg Community Club, a volunteer at Tuckahoe State Park, and a member of the Queen Anne's County Youth Chorale Committee. She enjoyed spending time with her family, gardening, antiquing, cooking, and spending time in nature, including camping trips.

She is survived by her five children, Carol Gallo (Gene), Beth Higgs (Tommy),

Judy Conley (Paul), Joan Baxter (David) and Steve Shortall (Nancy); three sisters, Betty Callahan, Lynn Snyder, and Terri Benny; a brother, Ronnie Moore; fourteen grandchildren; twenty great-grandchildren, and her beloved pet, Buddy. She was preceded in death by her husband, Daniel Shortall; and a brother, Bryan Moore.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Friday, November 6 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where the family will receive friends on Thursday from 6-8 pm. Burial will follow at St. Peter's Catholic Cemetery, Queenstown, MD.
