



Elizabeth Ann Bishop

December 4, 1945 - February 25, 2021

Elizabeth “Ann” Bishop of Easton, Maryland passed away on February 25, 2021 at the University of Maryland Baltimore Washington Medical Center. She was 75 years old.

Born on December 4, 1945, she was the daughter of the late Joseph Tilghman Bishop and Helen Harner Bishop of Queenstown, MD.

Ann enjoyed a very wholesome upbringing while being raised on the family farm, Winona Farm on the beautiful Wye River. She graduated from Centreville High School in 1963 and Wesley College in 1965. Ann furthered her career when she graduated as a Medical Records Librarian in 1966 as well as attending Virginia Commonwealth University and University of Maryland. She had a long career working as a Director of Medical Records in numerous hospitals before spending most of her career at the Easton Memorial Hospital from 1977 to 1995 and at the Chesapeake College office of records from 1995 to 2013, where she retired.

Ann was a faithful member at St. Marks United Methodist Church where she sang in the choir for over 25 years. She also was a member of the Bayside Quilters of the Eastern Shore and was a dedicated volunteer in her community to numerous local events, charities and organizations. She had a lifetime interest in the arts, photography, travel and cooking. She was known as an

extremely creative woman, a true artist.

Ann was a devoted caregiver to her parents, a loving aunt and loyal friend.

Ann is survived by her beloved cat “Addie”; brother Charles “Tim” Bishop and his wife Laura of Queenstown, MD; Niece Julie Ann Bishop and her children Alexandra and Bishop Chazen of Los Angeles, CA; Cousins John and Bonnie Roschy of Centreville, MD; Cousin Kathryn Bishop of Ft. Lauderdale, FL; and several cousins in Ohio.

A graveside service will be held on Saturday, June 26, 2021 at 11:30 am in Chesterfield Cemetery in Centreville, MD.

She never hesitated to enthusiastically jump into our explorations of painting, dying, printing and manipulating fabric in new ways. She contributed her artistic talent by participating in many collaborative quilts and always entered something fabulous to our biennial quilt shows in Oxford. She was generous with her time and talents and will be sorely missed by her circle of friends.

It was always fun to hear her stories of growing up on the family farm in the Carmichael area of Queen Anne's County. Lemon Butter

6 Eggs, well beaten

2 c. sugar

1 c. fresh lemon juice

8 T butter

In the top of a double boiler, melt butter. Remove from heat and add sugar and eggs. Mix well and return to heat, whisking until thickened and well blended - approx. 10 min. It will be the consistency of a cream sauce. It will thicken more once it is

refrigerated.

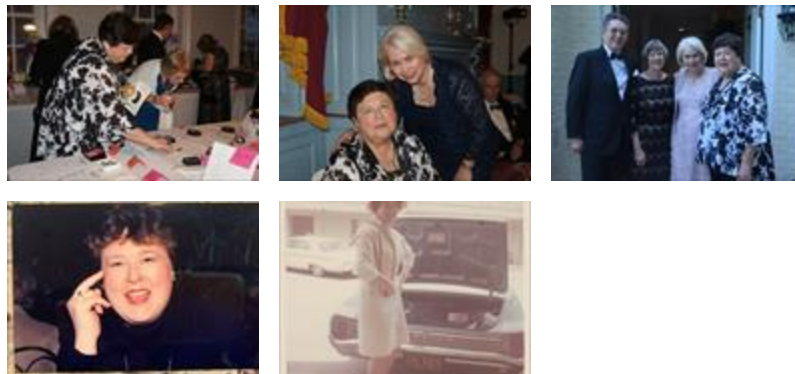
