Elizabeth Anne “Beth” Blair beloved special education teacher at Queen Anne’s County High School, MD passed away on December 7, 2017. She was 53.

Beth was born on December 20, 1963 in Neubrucke, Germany, the daughter of John Michael and Ruth Ann Grimes Herold of Grasonville, MD. Beth received her education at Concord College, WV with a BS in Education, where she pursued a passionate career working with special education students.

Beth was an active member of Christ’s Church Parrish, Kent Island MD. Her church participation was highlighted by a mission trip to Kenya with her daughter Haley and mother Ruth Anne. She especially enjoyed her extended family at Club One fitness while pursuing her passion of fitness and marathon races.

In addition to her parents Col. John and Ruth Ann Herold, Beth is survived by her daughter Haley Lynne Blair of Delmar, MD; dog John Henry “the Frenchy” of Dallas TX.
