Elizabeth Cook, 85, of Easton, MD, died on Monday, May 1, 2017, at Genesis HealthCare at The Pines in Easton. She was born on October 2, 1931, in Millington, MD, daughter of the late John Wesley Pearson and Mary Elizabeth Walls.

Elizabeth was the oldest of three sisters. She grew up in Sudlersville, MD. In 1939, she and her family moved to Wye Heights Plantation, where she remained for the next 71 years, employed with the Wyman family. She was known for her generosity, always cooking, baking, painting, and wallpapering for whomever needed it at no charge. Mrs. Cook contracted rheumatic fever at the young age of 11, surviving and finishing her education at home. For many years, she was very active in the Easton Church of the Nazarene, holding several key positions in the church. She enjoyed bowling, traveling, and, most importantly, her family.

Mrs. Cook is survived by her husband of 66 years, Gordon Lee Cook; two sons, Gordon "Inky" Lee Cook, Jr., and his wife Janice and Timmy Cook and his wife Donna; a daughter, Sylvia Pinder and her husband Gary; seven grandchildren, Lee Cook, Hope Bonnell, Jason Cook, Justin Cook, Tamara Rust, Ashley Cook and Jed Wooters; nine great-grandchildren, Jadon, Macy, Sarah, Alyssa, Taylor, Brandon, Jacob, Natalie and Parker; and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by a son, Stephen Arthur Cook, Sr.;

a grandson, Stephen Arthur Cook, Jr.; and two sisters, Sadie Wooters and Mable Mench.

A funeral service will be held on Monday, May 8, 2017, at 11 a.m. at the First Wesleyan Church of Easton, 620 Goldsborough St., in Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service. Interment will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park on Rt. 50 near Easton.

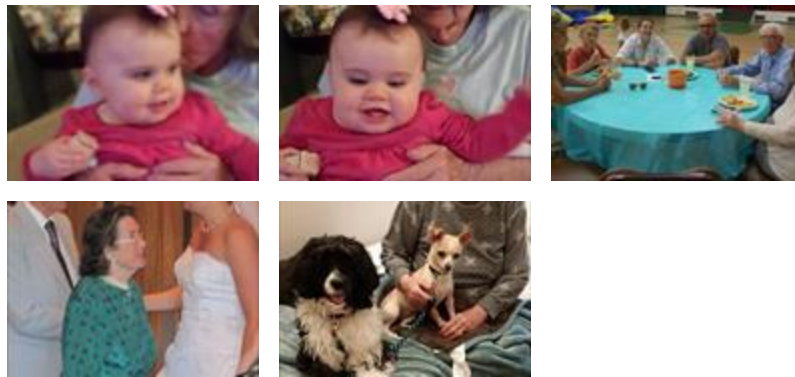

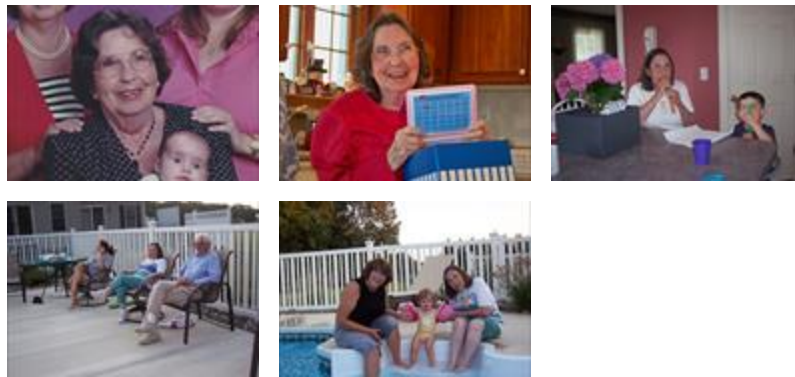

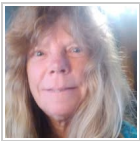
