August 26, 1929 - March 29, 2011

Elizabeth M. Lyons Davis of Chestertown, MD died on Tuesday, March 29, 2011 at the Chester River Hospital Center. She was 81 years old.

Mrs. Davis was born on August 26, 1929 at Clifton Springs Hospital in Clifton Spring, New York. She was the daughter of the late William James and Leno Weisenberger Lyon of Phelps, New York. Mrs. Davis graduated from Phelps Central School in 1946. In 1950, she graduated as a Registered Nurse from Louise de merlae Hospital (Sisters of Charity) in Buffalo, New York. In 1951, she enlisted in the United States Air Force as 2nd Lieutenant. She was stationed at Mitchell Air Force Base in Hempstead, Long Island and was transferred to Griffith Air Force base in Rome, New York. Mrs. David was honorably discharged in 1952. She married James F. Davis, Jr. on November 3, 1951. After being discharged from the United States Air force in 1952, they moved to Maryland, "God's Country", where they raised two daughters and two sons. Mrs. Davis was a part time nurse at several local hospitals. She opened an Industrial Nursing Station at Vita Foods in Chestertown, MD for several years. She was then employed with the Kent County Health Department for 26 years as a Public Health Nurse. Mrs. Davis enjoyed traveling, gardening, playing cards and reading. She was a member of the Republican Women's Club of Kent and Queen Anne's County and a member of the Red Hat Society.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by one son; Stephen J. Davis of Stevensville, MD, two daughters; Mary E. Downs and husband Lester of

Centreville, MD and Jane K. Feigleson and husband Tom of Chestertown, MD, three brothers; William Lyon of Marian, NY, Joseph D. Lyon of Rochester, NY and Richard Lyon of Lyons, NY, four sisters; Helen Phillips of Sodus, NY, Shirley Krenzer of Rochester, NY, May Conklin of Phelps, NY and Patricia Jones of Lyons, NY, three grandson; twins, Richard and Clay Coppage and Harry Feigleson and many cousins. In addition to her parents, she is predeceased by one son, Thomas L. Davis.

Funeral Services will be held privately. Interment will be in St. Paul's Cemetery, Chestertown, MD.
