Elizabeth Speer Deisroth of Parkville, Maryland, formerly of Rock Hall, Maryland, died on June 8, 2007 at Oak Crest View Nursing Facility. She was 93.

Born in Philadelphia, PA on November 24, 1913, she was the daughter of the late, Philip Speer and Elizabeth Martin Young. Following graduation from business school in Philadelphia she worked as a secretary for many different companies. She met her husband, Jack Deisroth, at a USO like tour in Alabama.
