Elizabeth “Betsy” Voelker Didier of Grasonville, MD died Friday March 28, 2008 after a 3 year battle with cancer at home surrounded by her beloved family. She was 73.

Born on September 1, 1934 in Baltimore, MD the daughter of the late Joseph G. Voelker and Margaret Wilkens. After raising her family Betsy graduated from the Community College of Baltimore with an Associates Degree. She would later receive her B.A. from Loyola College and follow up with her Masters Degree in Education also from Loyola College. Betsy taught for schools starting at St. Dominic’s in Baltimore, Anne Arundel County, Queen Anne’s County and Chesapeake College. She married Kenneth B. Didier in 1972 and in 1989 they would move to Grasonville, MD. Throughout the years Betsy was active with her church at St. Anthony’s in Baltimore, MD and St. Christopher’s in Chester, MD where she taught Sunday school and was very active with various ministries. She also was a volunteer at the Red Cross teaching sign language, enjoyed crafts such as crocheting and knitting, gardening and will be remembered for her artistic abilities.

She is survived by her husband Kenneth B. Didier of Grasonville, MD daughter; Stephanie F. McDermott and her husband Bernie of Baltimore, MD son; Mathew J. Zeller and his wife Lori of Abington, MD son; Richard A. Zeller
