Elizabeth "Lib" Dunleavy of Easton, formerly of Tilghman, died Tuesday, October 11, 2011 at Genesis Health Care, The Pines.

Born February 6, 1916 in Queen Anne's County, she was the daughter of late Earnest F. and Elizabeth Smith Cummings. During her working career she worked 40 years for Tilghman Packing Company with her final position being a supervisor. She then took a position at Harbourtowne Restaurant as a kitchen supervisor, where she remained until retiring in the early 1980's. She loved bingo, bowling and originating her own crab cake recipes; of which one was named in her honor called Miss Lib's. She also loved spending time with her family and enjoyed eating.

Her husband, Ambrose "Bud" Dunleavy died in 1985. Her only daughter, Patricia "Patsy" Haddaway, died September 16, 2010.
