



Elizabeth Eley Fleming

January 30, 1931 - February 5, 2021

Elizabeth (Betty) E. Fleming was born January 30th, 1931. On February 5th, 2021, Betty passed away peacefully at the age of 90.

Her loving parents were Howard and Elizabeth C. Eley of Queen Anne. She attended schools in Queen Anne and Centerville. She completed her high school education at National Cathedral School for girls in Washington, DC. She graduated from Duke University in 1953. While at Duke, she majored in psychology with a minor in English and sociology. Her volunteer work included working at Duke Hospital as a nurse's aide.

After graduating college, Betty taught school on the western shore until she married Lloyd (Bill) H. Fleming, Jr. in 1954, who was attending the University of Maryland. They moved to Easton after their first child, Donna, who was born in 1955. They grieved the loss of their first son, Richard, but were blessed with another son, Craig, born in 1958.

She served on the Talbot County Mental Health and Channel Marker Boards for many years. She was a Board member of the Y.M.C.A., Junior Auxiliary of the Memorial Hospital Association and member of Talbot County Garden Club. After the passing of her father in 1979, she and her sister continued the management of the family business (Eley & Moore). As a member

of St. Marks Methodist Church, she worked on various committees and served on the Prison Ministry. Her hobbies were tennis, decoupage, portrait art, landscaping and travel.

She visited many countries with her family, including Africa when her daughter was a missionary.

She is survived by her son, Craig, and her grandchildren Christine Kral (Mike), Joshua Borges (Jessica) and their children Asher and Judah, and David Borges (Sarah) and their sons, Blake and Mark, and a beloved sister, Sarah Kagan (Tim) and their children.

A Graveside Service will be held on February 12th (Friday) 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at the Greenmount Cemetery, Hillsboro, MD.
