Elizabeth Anne Elburn Freyman passed away peacefully on January 3, 2022, at the Compass Hospice Center in Centreville, Maryland, at the age of 96. She was born in Baltimore, MD, on July 6, 1925, the daughter of the late Grover and Mary Brooks.

After graduating high school in Baltimore, MD, she along with her husband, John E. Elburn, were lifeguards at Tolchester Beach, on Maryland's Eastern Shore. She was a loving mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother.

She is predeceased by her husbands, John "Booty" E. Elburn of Rock Hall, MD, and Charles Freyman of Baltimore MD; her brother, Cleveland Herbert Brooks; and sister, Catherine Brooks Leight.

She is survived by her three daughters, Linda Ellison, Rosemary Elburn and

Elburn, Jr., and his wife Carol; two grandsons and two granddaughters; four great-grandsons; one great-granddaughter; numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
