September 23, 1916 - November 13, 2009

Elizabeth P. Lalama of Centreville, MD was ushered in to be with her Lord and Savior on November 13, 2009 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. She was 93.

She was born in Leetsdale, PA on September 23, 1916 the daughter of the late, Michael and Anna Vohar Pcsolyar. A graduate of Leetsdale High School she worked at D.T. Watson Home for Crippled Children in Sewickley, PA. Mrs. Lalama then worked as a Governess for the Brooks Family and the Ray Family both in Sewickley until she married Guy J. Lalama on September 11, 1954. They made their home in Beaver, PA where she raised her family.

She was a member of the St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church and attended Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Beaver, PA.

Mrs. Lalama was a member of the Auxiliary at Beaver Valley Geriatrics Center and belonged to the Junior Women's Club of Beaver. In 1993 she and her husband moved to Centreville, MD to be closer with her daughter and family. Her husband predeceased her in 1994.

Mrs. Lalama enjoyed art, ceramics, writing letters of encouragement to others, baking, cooking, and gardening.

She is survived by her daughter, Dianne Cimba and her husband, Bob of
