Elizabeth Masterman of Denton, Maryland, formerly of Waynesboro, Virginia died on Friday November 26, 2004 at Homestead Manor in Denton. She was 81.

Her lifelong career was as a concert pianist and a piano / organ private instructor on the college level. She also served with her husband more than 60 years in music evangelism.
