



Elizabeth Pierson

June 21, 1921 - March 30, 2009

Homemaker and former teacher Elizabeth W. "Betty" Pierson, an Easton resident for 21 years, died of Alzheimer's Disease Monday, March 30, 2009 at the Gardens at William Hill Manor in Easton. She was 88.

Elizabeth Ives Wilcox was born June 21, 1921, in Baltimore, the daughter of the late Louis and Mary Colt Wilcox. Like her mother, she graduated from Goucher College after attending Girls Latin School in Baltimore. She served at one time on the Goucher College Alumnae Board.

For several years, Mrs. Pierson was a part time teacher at the School of Chimes and St. Leo's in Little Italy in Baltimore.

In 1945, she married John A. Pierson, also a Baltimorean and a U.S. Navy bomber pilot during World War II. He died in May of 2001. The Piersons lived in Roland Park for more than 40 years.

While in Baltimore she was a member of the Junior League's Brighter Morning Club, Young Audiences and Woodland Garden Club. She and her husband also belonged to the Gibson Island Club, where they enjoyed playing golf. In Easton, she became a member of the Harbor Club of the Eastern Shore and the National Society of the Colonial Dames of Maryland.

Her hobbies included reading, playing bridge and writing notes to friends and family.

She is survived by two daughters, Liz Freedlander of Easton and Anna A. Pierson of Annapolis; a son John B. Pierson of Towson; her sister, Joan Creighton of Baltimore; five grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Private graveside services will be held at 10:30 am Thursday, April 2 at St. Mary's Cemetery in Baltimore.
