Elizabeth Ann "Liz" Sullivan Platt of Easton, MD, died peacefully at home on October 8, 2014, surrounded by her husband, children, and sister.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on April 4, 1936, she was the daughter of the late Walter E. and Dorothy V. Sullivan. Liz graduated from Lower Marion High School in 1953, and married William M. Platt on December 18, 1954. After they married, they were stationed in Nurnberg, Germany, until 1956.
