



Elizabeth P. Scofield

July 11, 1922 - October 5, 2014

Elizabeth (Liz) Plumley Scofield of St. Michaels, MD, died peacefully on October 5, 2014, at Candle Light Cove Assisted Living in Easton, MD. She was 92.

Born on July 11, 1922, in Stamford, CT, she was the daughter of the late Richard Gardiner and Mable Sponsel Plumley. Mrs. Scofield earned a degree in Fine Arts from Skidmore College in 1944. She served as a Lieutenant in the United States Navy from 1944-1946. On February 12, 1947, she married the late Ralsey B. Scofield, Jr., in Stamford, CT, where they resided until moving to St. Michaels, MD in 1976.

Mrs. Scofield was a member of the Stamford Garden Club, St. Michaels Art League, St. John's Episcopal Church in Stamford, CT, and Christ Church in St. Michaels. She also volunteered at the Academy of the Arts in Easton.

Liz was pre-deceased by her husband and is survived by their three children and their spouses, John R. Scofield and Mary Ellen Olcese, Nancy S. Masone and John, and Richard G. Scofield and Robin; six grandchildren, Rob Masone and Shelly, Jesse Masone and Rebekah, Benjamin Masone, Asa Reeves and Becky, Ian Scofield, and Maura Olcese; four great-grandchildren, Violet Masone, Dominic Masone, Alyssa Hellmann and Isaac Ralsey Reeves.
