Elizabeth Swift Stehle, “Betty” passed away at her home in Trappe, MD on Friday, August 13, 2021. Betty was loved by all that knew her, she was a kind and gentle soul. She was 99!

Betty was born on October 14, 1921, in Oxen Hill, MD. She was the daughter of the late Wilmer Edward Swift and Viola Pearl Stewart Swift.

She graduated from McKinley Tech High School in Washington, D.C. in 1939.

In November 1942, she married John N. “Buddy” Stehle in Annapolis, MD.
