



Elizabeth Lee Wasserman

August 27, 1940 - January 15, 2012

Elizabeth Lee Wasserman of Centreville, MD, died on January 15, 2012. She was 71.

Born on August 27, 1940, in Clarke County, VA, she was the daughter of the late, Lee and Elizabeth Shumate Murray. She graduated from Chatham Hall with the Class of 1958 in Virginia and attended the Rhode Island School of Design. She married Max Judd Wasserman, who predeceased her in 1988, and in 1989, she moved to Centreville.

Mrs. Wasserman worked on Capitol Hill as the Chief of Staff for a Member of Congress and retired from the U.S House of Representatives Office of Official Recorders. Subsequent to that she worked many years in the private sector as a court reporter.

She was a very active member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centreville where she was involved with the altar guild, the lay Eucharistic ministry, and the prayer shawl ministry. She was also a long time member of the Maryland Sporting Dog Association, the Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of America, and an officer in the Greater Chesapeake Welsh Springer Spaniel Club. She enjoyed raising and showing Welsh Springer Spaniels, sailing, boating, and knitting.

She is survived by her children, Jonathan Wasserman of Chestertown, MD, and Lucienne Elizabeth Rose Simone and her husband, Matthew; along with their daughter, Brielle, all of Woodbridge, VA.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, January 20, 2012, at 11 a.m. at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centreville, MD.

Interment will held at a later date in Green Hill Cemetery in Berryville, VA.
