May 18, 1954 - December 7, 2008

Elizabeth “Beth” A. Northrop Vogel of Trappe, MD died on Sunday, December 7, 2008 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD, after courageously enduring cancer. Family was gathered in prayer at her bedside. She was 54.

Born May 18, 1954 in Indianapolis, Indiana, she was the daughter of Patricia J. McDonald Northrop of Denton, MD and the late John “Jack” Northrop, Sr. After graduating from Laurel High School, Laurel, MD in 1972, she attended Anne Arundel Community College. She later received her nursing degree from Angelo State University in San Angelo, TX. In January of 1980 she married Richard B. Vogel at Ft. Meade, MD. They made their home in various places, while he served in the U.S. Air Force, until moving to Trappe, MD in 1995. She worked as a Psychiatric Nurse at the Chesapeake Youth Center in Cambridge until retiring for health reasons.

As a youth she was very active in sports. She played softball and while attending community college she coached softball with the Anne Arundel Parks and Recreation Service.

In addition to her mother and husband, Mrs. Vogel is survived by four children, Richard Dean Vogel and his wife Katie of Catonsville, Charles Alan Vogel and his wife Jennifer of Cordova, Jeremy Daniel Vogel and his wife Shelby of Easton, and Mary Patricia Vogel of Easton and her fiancé Andrew J. Cain; a

sister, Susanne Marie Draper and her husband David of Easton; two brothers, John J. Northrop, Jr. and his wife Laura of Royal Oak and Scott McDonald Northrop and his wife Kathy of Queenstown; and three grandchildren, Grant Tyler, Gemma MacIntyre, and Sophia Jean Vogel.
