Elizabeth B. "Liz" Bennett of Chestertown, MD died Wednesday, April 23, 2008 at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 77.

Born September 10, 1930 in Tyler, TX, she was the daughter of the late, William J. Beaver and Lillie Mae Clark. Liz graduated from Chestertown High School in 1947 and then attended Goldey-Beacom College where she met and married her husband. In 1949, they lived in Chestertown where she was employed by the Department of Social Services in Centreville, MD and then by Kunkles Auto Parts in Chestertown. She and her husband moved to Columbus, OH where she was employed as a Secretary at Ohio State University. She was then employed at the Batelle Memorial Institute as an analyst of Soviet capabilities during the "Cold War."

In 1955, she moved to Albuquerque, New Mexico where she was employed by the Sandia Corporation. She also lived for a short time in 1959 in Seattle, Washington before moving to Bethesda, MD in 1960 where her role was that of a mother and home manager.

In 1980 she moved to Searborough, NY before returning to Chestertown, MD in 1990. Liz enjoyed playing badminton, golf and bridge. She enjoyed many peaceful moments, tending to her roses and gazing at the Chester River. She also enjoyed her family and friends who were particularly grateful for her

loving heart and caring support in their time of need.

She is survived by her husband, Dr. William F. Bennett and her beloved daughter, Karen Elizabeth Bennett. She is also survived by many nieces and nephews, including a very special niece, Shelley Smith and her husband, Richard of Centreville, MD.

Liz was preceded in death by several brothers and sisters, Bertha Smith, Frances Quimby, Marguerite Beaver, Frank Beaver, Fred Beaver and William Beaver.
