Elizabeth B. Rossiter, known to all as “Betty”, died at her home on October 22, 2001, after a courageous fight with lung cancer. She was 78.

Born March 31, 1923, she was the daughter of the late John and Mary Kennady Bartholow. Betty attended the University of South Carolina, but left during the war to work for the Coastal and Geographic Society, where she drew maps that were used for the invasion of France. She also taught Art at the Calvert School in Baltimore.

She was the loving wife of Ehrick Gordon Rossiter whom she married on September 13, 1947 in Baltimore, MD. They spent most of their 54 wonderful years together in Summit, NJ, with summers in Edgartown, MA and then retired to Hilton Head Island, SC until moving to Easton, MD seven years ago. They have lived in the retirement community of Londonderry for the past year. She enjoyed the Eastern Shore and all it had to offer, including, antiques, gardening and the close proximity of family. She was a member of the Talbot Country Club and the Harbor Club.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Rossiter is survived by two daughters, Patti Ravenscroft of Washington, DC and Polly White of Severna Park, MD; a brother John Bartholow of Tiburion, CA and five grandchildren.

Services will be held on Monday, October 29, 2001 at the Laurel Episcopal Church, Laurel, MD at 11:00 AM. Burial will be at Ivy Hill Cemetery, Laurel, MD.
