Elizabeth B. 'Bets' Trammell, of Easton, died at her home on Monday, September 28, 2009. She was 82 years old.

Born in Berwyn, MD, September 8, 1927, she was the daughter of the late, Carroll L. and Hazel Ogle Beckwith. After graduating from Hyattsville High School, she worked for the U.S. Government.
