A Funeral Liturgy for Elizabeth D. Hubbard, of Easton, will be celebrated at Saints Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, on Tuesday, December 17th, at 10 A.M.

Mrs. Hubbard died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Thursday, December 12, 2002. She was 54.

Born in Easton, December 25, 1947, she was the daughter of Lena Moffa Dickerson of Easton and the late Paul A. Dickerson. A lifelong resident of Talbot County, Mrs. Hubbard, or Libby as she was best-known, was a member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church. She was also an active member and past officer of the Ladies Auxiliary of E. E. Streets Memorial Post #5118, V.F.W. where she devoted many hours to their community activities. She enjoyed crocheting, other handicrafts and entertaining at children's' parties.

At the time of her death, she was the owner-operator of Hubbard's Cupboard, a craft shop in Easton which she had operated for four years. Prior to that, she had been the Program Coordinator at the Talbot Senior Center in Easton.

Surviving, in addition to her mother, are her devoted husband, Paul F. Hubbard whom she married December 16, 1995; a son, Michael J. Dickerson of Easton; two sisters, Paula M. Scalph of Port Richey, FL and Rita M. Patrick

of Easton; a brother, William J. Dickerson of Easton and two grandchildren, Drew and Megan Dickerson, both of Trappe.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
