Elizabeth M. Brunner of Denton, MD died on Sunday, December 22, 2002 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 94.

Born May 15, 1908 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Charles H. McGinn and the late Sarah Gertrude Tarbutton McGinn Henry. Her stepfather, John Winder Henry, Jr., died in 1964. She was a 1925 graduate of Easton High School. After attending Towson State Normal School, she was employed by J. S. Johnson in Baltimore, MD, makers of rope, twine, fishing tackle, etc. On March 10, 1933 she married George William Brunner. She lived in Baltimore until November of 2001 when she moved to Homestead Manor in Denton, MD.

She was an active member of Wildwood Parkway United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Brunner is survived by several cousins and seven step nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, December 27, 2002 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service. The Rev. Dr. George A. Stansbury will officiate.
