Elizabeth Gamble Thompson Huber of Cambridge, MD, formerly of Easton, MD, died on Friday, September 13, 2002 at Dorchester General Hospital, Cambridge, after a 35 year battle with Multiple Sclerosis. She was 76.

Born August 26, 1926 in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of the late George and Frances Thompson. After attending public school in Philadelphia, she received her teaching degree from West Chester State Teachers College and then her Masters Degree from Columbia University in 1972. She was a learning disabilities specialist for several public school systems in Northern New Jersey. She moved to Talbot County in 1992 and to Cambridge 3 years ago.

Mrs. Huber's husband, Roger Albert Huber, whom she married January 17, 1948 died on June 18, 1998.

Mrs. Huber is survived by 5 children, Dr. Lare Huber of Portland, ME, Madge Huber Henning of Oxford, MD, Grant Huber of Annapolis, MD, Evans Huber of Wayland, MA and Gamble Foster of Cambridge, MD; one brother, T. Evans Thompson of King of Prussia, PA and 7 grandchildren. In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by a sister, Elaine Nelke and 2 grandchildren, Tonio Henning and Oliver Huber.

Services will be held at Trinity Cathedral, Easton, MD on Monday, September 16, 2002 at 3:00 PM.

Burial will be at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
