Elizabeth Washington Ridley of Londonderry, Easton, MD died on Monday February 23, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 91.

Born November 24, 1912 in Riverton, NJ, she was the daughter of the late George Lincoln and Christine Washington Ridley. After graduating from Saint Mary's Hall in Burlington, NJ in 1930, she worked for several years in Philadelphia. During World War II she worked as a social worker for the American Red Cross Chapter of Burlington County, NJ. She then moved to Washington, D.C. where she took a position as the Employee Relations Officer at the Library of Congress. She retired on December 31, 1979 after thirty-three years with the library.

Miss Ridley is survived by two sisters, Christine W. Ridley, with whom she shared her home since 1955, and Mrs. Robert L. Lippincott, both of Londonderry; four nephews, Richard W. Lippincott and his wife "Pucky" of Oxford, MD, Lt. Col. Robert L. Lippincott, USAF, ret. and his wife Joanne of Poquoson, VA, William R. Lippincott and his wife Fay Jean of St. Michaels, MD, and John H. Lippincott and his wife Ennis of Montana; three great nephews, four great nieces, two great-great nephews, and two cousins, Mrs. Howland Dudley of Doylestown, PA and Mr. George S.W. Cumpston and his wife Eileen of Swansboro, NC.

A memorial service will be held at a later date at The Church of The Holy Trinity Episcopal Church, Oxford, MD.

Private inurnment will be at Zion Episcopal Church, Charlestown, West Virginia.
