



Ellen Mary Reskovitz Brady

August 4, 1931 - November 3, 2014

Ellen Mary Reskovitz Brady of Chestertown, MD, died on Monday, November 3, 2014, at Christiana Hospital Center in Newark, DE. She was 83.

Born on August 4, 1931, in Wilmington, DE, she was the daughter of the late Ralph A. and Helen Lucey Reskovitz. Mrs. Brady graduated Wilmington High School, Class of 1950. She married Peter J. Van Veen, who predeceased her. On April 24, 1970, she remarried to Edward F. Brady, who predeceased her in 1997. They resided in Tolchester, MD.

Mrs. Brady worked as a secretary with Wilmington Trust, New Castle Air Base, Sears, and most recently with DuPont for the remainder of her career, until her retirement in the 1980's. While raising her children, she also ran a daycare business from home.

Mrs. Brady was a member of St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall, Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church in Chestertown, and the Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion, Post #228 – Ladies Auxiliary in Rock Hall. She enjoyed spending time with family and friends, having fun, and dining out.

Mrs. Brady is survived by two sons, Peter J. Van Veen and his wife Alice of Elkton, MD, and David Van Veen of Chestertown, MD; a daughter, Carol E. Van Veen of Chestertown, MD; a stepson, Edward Brady and his wife Marie of

Selbyville, DE; eight grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

Services will be held on Thursday, November 6, 2014, at 11 a.m. at St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall. A visitation will be held prior to the service, from 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Chestertown. Interment will be in St. John's Cemetery, following the service.
