November 19, 1922 - November 7, 2010

Ellen Ross Coleman of Chestertown, MD died on Sunday, November 7, 2010 Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville, MD. She was 87 years old.

Born on November 19, 1922 in Sudlersville, MD, she was the daughter of the late, John Price and Marim Duling Johnson. Mrs. Coleman graduated from Sudlersville High School, Class of 1939 and in 1943 she received her B. A. Degree from Mary Washington College in Fredricksburg, VA. On December 27, 1947 she married Robert Neal Coleman of Millington, MD. Mrs. Coleman taught English and Social Studies at Ridgley High School, Sudlersville High School and Queen Anne's County High School. She retired from Queen Anne's County School System in 1974.

She was a member of the Maryland State and Queen Anne's County Teacher's Association, American Legion Ladies Auxiliary, and the Kent County Chapter of the American Red Cross. She is also a member of the Calvary Asbury United Methodist Church in Sudlersville, MD. Mrs. Coleman loved to read, and enjoyed volunteering for many years at the Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital and the Magnolia Hall Nursing Home.

In addition to her parents she was also preceded in death by her husband in 2004.

She is survived by, two sister in laws, Patricia Moore of Kentmore Park, MD and Mildred Coleman of Seaford, DE; a brother in law, Glen Coleman of Wilmington, DE and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral Services will be held on Wednesday, November 10, 2010 at 1:00 PM at Calvary Asbury United Methodist Church in Sudlersville, MD where relatives and friends may call after 12 noon.
