Ellen Carson Casbarian, 74, passed away on Saturday, July 11, 2009 at her residence in Sherwood Forest, MD. Ellen was born in Washington, D.C. on February 12, 1935 and is the daughter of the late Earl and Fannie (Wright) Carson.

Ellen attended Woodrow Wilson High School in the District and was a 1956 graduate of the University of Maryland where she earned her B.S. degree. While a Senior at Maryland, she was President of her Sorority, Delta Delta Delta. For 20 years she was a summer resident of Sherwood Forest, making her permanent home there in 1983. An avid tennis player, Ellen enjoyed a variety of community activities, most recently the "morning coffee group" and events involving the Sherwood Retirees.

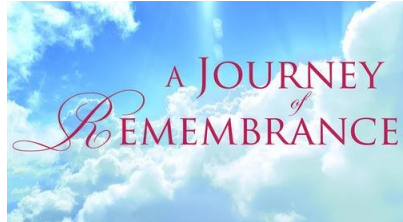
