



Ellsworth S. Haddaway Sr.

Ellsworth S. Haddaway Sr. of Tilghman died at the Memorial Hospital at Easton on Thursday, June 14, 2007. He was 85.

Born in Tilghman on March 15, 1922 he was the son of the late Roland Sr. and Mamie Crockett Haddaway. After attending Talbot County public schools he, in 1942, enlisted in the United States Coast Guard where he served on the U.S.S. Mayflower. Following his release from active duty in 1946 he returned to Tilghman where he began a lifelong career working as a commercial waterman.

Mr. Haddaway was a member of the Tilghman United Methodist Church; other memberships include the B.P.O. Elks Lodge #1622 of Easton and E.E. Streets 5118 V.F.W. of Easton.

In addition to his wife, the former Patricia "Patsy" Dunleavy whom he married in June of 1948, Mr. Haddaway is survived by a son; Ellsworth Haddaway Jr. and his wife Karen of Tilghman, a daughter; Pamela D. Haddaway of Easton, one sister; Norma Curcio of North Carolina, three grandchildren; Cara Chance and her husband Brandon, Chris Brennicks and his wife Tabatha, and Jodi Brennicks, his loving mother in law; Elizabeth "Miss Lib" Dunleavy of Tilghman, special friends; Gus and Nini Sadler of Easton and many nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents he was

predeceased by two brothers; Roland Haddaway Jr. and Orem N. Haddaway Sr.

A memorial service will be held at 3 PM on Thursday, June 21, 2007 at the Tilghman United Methodist Church, Tilghman, MD.

Burial will be private.
