Ellwood Stanley Smith died Sunday, March 28, at his home in Stevensville, MD, surrounded by his family and friends after a lengthy illness. He was 80.

Born in Ridgely, MD, on April 23, 1923, he was the son of the late Eli and Lydia Bilcking Smith. He was one of fourteen children and spent most of his life working as a waterman. He was also an accomplished carpenter, welder, and boat builder.
