Elma (El) Evans, 86, a Talbot County native and long-time resident of Cheverly, Maryland, died on Monday, September 10th at The Hospice of Volusia/Flagler in Daytona Beach, Florida, after a brief illness.

Mrs. Evans became a nurse at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore. She practiced as both a registered nurse and later as a public health nurse for Prince Georges County.

Mrs. Evans was active in St. John's Lutheran Church in Riverdale as well as in civic and school organizations in Prince Georges County before moving to Florida in 1994. She was an active member of All Saints Lutheran Church in Port Orange, Florida, the Maryland Club in Daytona Beach, and was a long-time volunteer at Florida Memorial Hospital.
