Elma V. Harrington died of natural causes at her home in Easton, Md. on Sunday, November 13, 2005. She was 89.

Born on August 26, 1916 in Bethlehem, Md, she was the daughter of the late Lawrence E. and Viola Williamson LeGates. Following her graduation from Preston High School in 1933, she worked for Noble Motor Co. and Riley's Coffee Shop in Easton and the Pasadena Inn in Royal Oak. In December 1946 she married Paul G. Harrington. While Mr. Harrington served in the U.S. Navy during WWII and Korea, Mrs. Harrington traveled with her husband and worked in Navy Civil Service. In 1974, following their respective retirements, she and her husband moved to back to her beloved Eastern Shore.

Mrs. Harrington, known affectionately as "Aunt Elma", touched everyone who met her and she will be dearly missed by her family and friends.

She was a member of the E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W. of Easton and Ladies of the Elks B.P.O. #1622 Lodge of Easton.

Mrs. Harrington is survived by numerous beloved nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by four brothers; Leonard LeGates, Willard LeGates, Lawrence LeGates, Jr, and Theodore LeGates, and three sisters; Reba Coulby, Anne Brooks and Mary Jane Cohee.

A graveside service at Junior Order Cemetery, Preston, will be held on Thursday, November 16, 2005, at 11:00 a.m.
