Elmer G. Crouse of Grasonville died at Memorial Hospital in Easton on August 16, 2001. He was 68.

Born on March 9, 1933 in Rock Hall, he was the son of the late Wilbur B. and Naomi Coleman Crouse. He attended school near Piney Neck in Rock Hall and later Ridgely High School in Caroline County. On September 25, 1955 he married the former Marjorie L. Pierson of Grasonville. Mr. Crouse served in the Korean Conflict in Korea. When he retired in 1956, he went to work for the State of Maryland on the William Preston Lane Memorial Bridge. He retired in 1983 as a maintenance foreman. Mr. Crouse worked part time for twenty five years at the Kent Island Yacht Club, also retiring in 1983. He was a member of the Grasonville V.F.W. Post #7464, American Legion Post #296, and the Bay Country Moose.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two daughters, Martha Ann Lutian of Annapolis and Cara Powell of Ellicott City, MD; a brother, Wilbur Crouse, Jr. of Las Vegas, Nevada; three sisters, Helen Knott of Ridgely, Beverly Wade of Bridgetown, MD and Jane Shahan of Cheswold, DE; and three grandchildren, Jessica R. Bachelor of Grasonville, and Joseph and Jacob Lutian of Annapolis.
