Elmer McMaster Pusey, Jr. "Mack" of Easton, died Friday, August 29, 2008 at William Hill Manor. He was 84.

Born on August 6, 1924 in Washington, D.C., he was the son of the late, Elmer McMaster Pusey and Hazel Griffith Pusey. He grew up in Chevy Chase, MD and served 3.5 years in the Army during WW II including combat in Europe. He was a 1945 graduate of Virginia Military Institute cum laude. He was an advertising production manager for National Geographic Society Magazine for 18 years. He completed his printing career at American Chemical Society.

Mack's interests included farming, fishing, hunting, water color painting, and sailing. He was a 50 year member of the Chevy Chase Presbyterian Church in Washington, D.C., where he served as deacon, elder, and a trustee. He had also served on the Planning and Zoning Board for Queen Anne's County, was a past president and board member of the Stronghold Inc at Sugar Loaf Mountain, MD and an active member of Centreville United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Betty B. Pusey; two daughters, Janet Finucane and Carol Roman and her husband, Bruce; a brother, Bradford Pusey; three grandchildren, Andrew Roman, Cameron Finucane, and Erin Finucane; five nieces and nephews, and several great nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held 11AM on Thursday, September 4th, 2008 at the Centreville United Methodist Church in Centreville, MD where family and friends may call one hour before.

Interment will be held privately in Bethesda, MD.
