February 7, 1925 - November 10, 2013

Eloise Margaret Crouch of Rock Hall, MD, passed away on November 10, 2013, at Easton Memorial Hospital. She was 88.

She was born on February 7, 1925, the daughter of the late Christopher and Margaret Creighton Grant.

Educated in Piney Neck she married Calvin Crouch, Sr., on January 27, 1948, and raised her family in Piney Neck on the outskirts of Rock Hall where she was born and raised.

She worked with her husband picking geese and ducks for area gun clubs, briefly as a waitress and cook-in area restaurants, and as a caregiver to the elderly in the community. She loved reading, watching her birds, viewing westerns, crocheting, growing flowers, and most of all, spending time with her extensive family.

She is survived by her daughters, Bonita Lee Clever of Hatteras, NC and Nora Jean Loeffler of Rock Hall, MD; a son, Calvin Elmer Crouch, Jr. of Felton, DE; along with 11 grandchildren; 26 great-grandchildren, and five great-great-grandchildren.

Graveside services will be held on Thursday, November 14, 2013, at 11 a.m. at Wesley Chapel Cemetery in Rock Hall.
