Elva S. Walker German died quietly and peacefully at 12:02 a.m. Monday, March 28. She was 104 years old and lived an active, productive life.

She was the wife of Lee W. German; mother of Robert L. German Pittsburgh, Pa.; grandmother of Robert R. German of Pittsburgh, Pa., Mark L. German of Annapolis, A. Barbara German of Ham-den, Conn., great-grandmother of four; great-great-grandmother of one; and aunt to three nephews and three nieces.

“Memaw,” as she was known to her many friends and relatives, was born Nov. 10, 1900, in Gloucester County, Va. She moved to Baltimore in 1922, and married. She attended “The Marinello School of Beauty Culture” and opened her own beauty salon in 1929. She continued working as a beautician for 65 years.

Elva and Lee moved to Stevensville on Memorial Day 1959. In August 1997, due to her advancing age and living alone, she chose to move to Manressa, an assisted living facility in Annapolis, In October 2003, she transferred to Millennium South River.
