



## Elwood A. Streeter Jr.

Elwood A. Streeter, Jr. of Centreville died on August 15, 2001 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital. He was 76.

Born on April 17, 1925 in the Hamden part of Baltimore, he was the son of the late Emma Shane and Elwood A. Streeter, Sr. When he was seventeen years old, he enlisted in the Army Air Corps and served in WWII. After the war, Mr. Streeter continued the trade he had learned as a machinist and retired from Westinghouse at B.W.I. after thirty one years of service. Mr. Streeter was married to Evelyn Shrives, who predeceased him in 1980. On June 11, 1983 he married the former Virginia Bradshaw of Baltimore. He was a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church and the United Methodist Men, the Kramer Senior Center, Centreville, the Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Maryland, the General Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons, International, the Boumi Temple of Baltimore, the Centreville Lodge #180 A.F. & A.M., the Grand Council of Royal & Select Masters of Maryland, the Grand Commandery, Knights Templar of Maryland, and the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, S.J.
