March 12, 1949 - January 15, 2010

E. Robert “Bob” Jackson, Jr. of Cambridge, MD died peacefully in his home on Friday, January 15, 2010. He was 60.

Born on March 12, 1949 and raised in Easton, MD, he was the son of Elwood and Madeline Jackson. After graduating from Easton High School in 1967, he went on to Elkins Institute of New Orleans to pursue his dream of becoming a disc jockey.
