



## Emerson W. Wheeler, Jr.

July 7, 1943 - May 17, 2011

Emerson Woodrow Wheeler, Jr. died on May 17, 2011 with his family by his side after a long battle with Parkinson's and Lewy Body Disease. He was 67.

Born in Dorchester County on July 7, 1943, he was the son of Marie E. Lewis Wheeler and the late Emerson W. Wheeler, Sr. After graduating from Easton High School, he served in the United States Army. He worked for a men's boutique, Blades and Company, and more recently, as a mortgage broker and owner of Mason Dixon Mortgage Company.

Mr. Wheeler was a devoted husband and father. He enjoyed playing tennis and golf, log canoeing, camping, fishing, hunting, vacationing on the Outer Banks in North Carolina and spending time outdoors. He was a coach for Talbot Lacrosse, and a member of the Miles River Yacht Club, the Talbot County Gun Club, Ducks Unlimited, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars EE Streets Memorial Post 5118.

He is survived by his daughter, Ashley N. Wheeler; his son, Emerson W. "Woody" Wheeler, III; his granddaughter, Emmah J. Lewis; his wife, Bonnie Wheeler; his brothers, Henry "Bird Dog" Wheeler and Wayne Wheeler; and his sister, Myra Wheeler Williams.
