Emil Ernst Schultz of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, May 7, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 88.

Born April 12, 1915 in Cordova, he was the son of the late Wilhelm F. and Helene Meta Jacobs Schultz. On November 2, 1940 he married Jane W. Brennan. Three months later he was sent to Ft. Meade for training. After the advent of World War II, he was sent to Europe with the 29th Division aboard the Queen Mary. In June 1944 he landed on Omaha Beach during the "D Day" invasion, and saw action in Northern France, Central Europe and the Rhineland. During this time he worked in the 729th and Ordinance Light Maintenance Company. He received the Army Good Conduct Medal and the European Theatre of Operations Medal. He returned home in 1945, at the end of the war, and worked as a mechanic for Hallowell Chevrolet. Later, he became a fleet mechanic for Koontz Creamery. He retired from the Pet Corporation in 1993 at age 78.

A member of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Easton, he was also a member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V.F.W. and B.P.O. Elks #1622.

Mr. Schultz is survived by two daughters, Mary Lynne Veltman of Towson, MD and Ann Schriver of Easton, MD; four grandchildren, Alison McDaniel, Thomas Veltman, Oliver Schriver and Mary Schriver; a sister, Dorothy G. Otto

of St. James, MN; and a brother, Bernhard G. Schultz of Preston, MD.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, May 13, 2003 at 10:00 AM at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Easton, MD. Pastor Kevin Graudin will officiate.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
