Emily H. Schubert, a resident of Easton, MD, passed away on December 8, 2017, at Genesis -The Pines in Easton, MD. She was 97.

She was born on December 9, 1919, to the late Richard and Sarah Hardisty in New York. Growing up, she lived on a tobacco and cattle farm in Mitchellville, MD, with her father while her mother worked in New York as a seamstress. The house in Mitchellville is now a historical home called Melford. After graduating business School in Baltimore, MD, Emily worked for the IRS, R.H. Slingluff Fertilizer Co. and retired from Bullock Construction Co.
