



## Emily Frances Dodd Morris

June 10, 1916 - August 16, 2011

Emily Frances Dodd Morris, formerly of Centreville, MD died on Tuesday, August 16, 2011 under hospice care at Rock Spring Village Assisted Living, Forest Hill, MD where she lived after an August 15, 2007 stroke damaged her speech. She was 95 years old.

Born June 10, 1916 in Carmichael, MD, Emily was the eldest daughter of the late Henry Dodd and Janie Elizabeth Donahue. Following her mother's stroke when Emily was in the ninth grade, Emily took care of her mother and the family home. Emily graduated from Centreville High School, Class of 1933. On September 20, 1940, she married Joseph Morris of Centreville, a farmer. She was a homemaker who dedicated her life to caring for her family. She took pride in the number of quarts of fruits and vegetables that she and her husband were able to preserve from their home garden and was well known for her baked goods.

She is survived by three children, Jane Morris Drupieski and husband, Thomas, of Bel Air, MD; Carl A. Morris of Queenstown, MD; J.
