Emily Maye Shaulis passed away on Monday, November 5, 2007 at her home after a lengthy illness. She was 84 years old.

Born on July 31, 1923 in Dembo, PA daughter of the late Samuel Reese and Ella Hudec Reese, she grew up in Isabella, PA. where she graduated high school. After attending college, she enlisted in the Navy and would serve during WWII. On October 14, 1946 she married William Franklin Shaulis, Sr. and they resided in Somerset, PA. Later they moved to Crownsville, MD where she worked as a waitress at Bonfire before working for the State of Maryland Comptroller's Office. She worked as a crossing guard for Anne Arundel County before retiring in the early 1970s. In 1984 they moved to Grasonville, MD where she loved bird watching, doing crafts, reading, playing games, and especially spending time with her family. She also volunteered at Grasonville Elementary School and had been a member of the Ladies of the Moose, Annapolis Chapter.

Emily Shaulis is survived by 3 daughters, Sandra K. Shaulis of Annapolis, MD, Ella Marie Angstadt of Elgin, SC, and Wilma Lee Phoebus of Grasonville, MD; son, William F. Shaulis, Jr of Centreville, MD; 10 grandchildren, 21 great grandchildren, and 4 great great grandchildren. She was predeceased by her husband, William Franklin Shaulis, Sr in 2001; daughter, Rose Ella Reese Stevens in 1996 and 2 brothers.
