



Ms. Emilywood Phillips

September 4, 1922 - December 1, 2011

Miss Emilywood Phillips, 89, of Middletown, DE and formerly of Tilghman Island, MD died on Thursday, December 1, 2011 at Christiana Hospital in Christiana, DE.

Born in Tilghman on September 4, 1922, she was the daughter of the late, H. Russell Phillips and Eula L. Marshall Phillips. After graduating from Tilghman High School in 1939, Miss Phillips completed two years of technical training at St. Michaels High School. She was employed for almost 20 years as secretary for Tilghman Packing Company. In 1960, she began her career with Getty Oil Company in Federalsburg, and later moved to Delaware where she remained with Getty until retiring in 1984 after 24 years of service.

She was a member of Bethesda United Methodist Church in Middletown and was a life member of the Delaware Getty Retirement Group.

Miss Phillips is survived by several cousins.
