



Emma Margaret Olszewsky

July 24, 1920 - November 1, 2014

Emma Margaret Olszewsky died on November 1, 2014, in Centreville, MD. She was 94.

She was born on July 24, 1920, in Philadelphia, PA. Emma was a veteran of WWII and served as a Capitan in the Army Nurse Corps in Hollandia and Biek, New Guinea in the South Pacific. She was a registered nurse with the Red Cross, Visiting Nurses Society of Philadelphia, and a Registered Nurse/Physical Therapist at Taylor Hospital in Ridley Park, PA, where she retired in 1976.

Emma was predeceased by her husband, George Olszewsky. She is survived by her daughter, Patricia J. Olszewsky of Wilmington, DE; two sons, George R. Olszewsky of Ridley Park, PA; and Michael F. Olszewsky of Centreville, MD; and eight grandchildren.

Interment will take place at Arlington National Cemetery at a later date.
