Emma Giese Saathoff of Easton, MD died on Friday, November 28, 2003 at home. She was 87.

Born August 26, 1916 in Cambridge, she was the daughter of the late Ernest Augustine and Theresia Howath Giese Saathoff. After graduating from Cambridge High School in 1932, she began a career working at Sears in Cambridge for over 35 years as a bookkeeper and audit clerk. During her working years, she also worked and assisted her husband on the Saathoff Dairy Farm. Upon her retirement from Sears, she began a second career learning to be a floral designer.

Mrs. Saathoff was married January 1948 to the late Bernard Ludwig Saathoff who died on February 9, 1993. She is survived by four daughters, Theresa Shortall of Elkton, Carol Frampton of Cordova, Linda Brown and Emma Jean Morgan both of Easton, six grandchildren and two sisters, Elizabeth G. Bosse of Easton and Margaret G. Asche of Cordova. She is predeceased by two sisters, Bertha G. Bradshaw and Louise A. Giese and one brother William Giese.

She was member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Easton, where she was a Sunday School teacher, member of the senior choir and the Ladies Aid and was

a pianist for Sunday School.

Funeral services will be on Wednesday, December 3, 2003 at 3:00 p.m. at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Internment will be at the New Springhill Cemetery in Easton.
